Minutes:

Tonight, Gary started the meeting at 8:00 P.M. EST.

Gary welcomed the members as they entered. Then, he suggested that we discuss the first item on the agenda, WikiProject. The main point centered

upon the focus on Mind/Body or QiGong emphasis. Maryann asked if all members present were added to the project.

Gary added his name at that point.

Kathy requested a copy of the agenda. Maryann emailed her copy. We did not select to use join.me because we concentrated on the WikiProject as the center and key focus of the meeting. The controversy became evident as we discussed our points.

We looked at the WikiProject on our own computers. Gary noticed that the focus morphed into much more than QiGong. Maryann pointed out the goals section of the WikiProject. Robert pointed to areas that he edited in other sections. Robert also found an area for a window of opportunity to set up a time line for the goals of the WikiProject. He suggested that we delete the words (everyone has had a chance to share their opinions) edit with more precise timing. No decisions were made about exact time plans yet. See the third paragraph of Guidelines and Goals:

We'll conduct live discussions on this the fourth Sunday of every month at 605-475-4333 code 919728. In between live discussions, please use the talk pages to expand your point of view. We are seeking agreement and consensus among the largest number of people, and will continue our conversations until everyone has had a chance to share their opinions, listen to other's opinions, and seek mutual understanding of the best way to achieve our goal. Since our time on the call is limited (we will try to restrict those conversations to 30 minutes), we would appreciate it if you would use the talk pages to share your opinions whenever possible.

Major points that added to the flow of conversations concerned the following areas:

- 1. peer reviewed and non-peer reviewed articles as topics in the WikiProject,
- 2. medical and healing modalities, historical documents,
- 3. viable topics that relate to the listings we have so far,
- 4. and editing for general areas that may not focus on QiGong. Lauro pointed out that QiGong should still be the primary focus. Sioban discussed the QiGong focus as well. Garth also discussed the medical community and QiGong.

Robert added that a proposed topic for the next meeting could be the letter that we will use to inform professionals and others about the WikiProject.
